

TOWN OF MENTOR, CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 104 OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF MENTOR, CLARK COUNTY, WISCONSIN ESTABLISHING THROUGH STREETS AND HIGHWAYS AND STREETS AND HIGHWAYS HAVING RIGHT-OF-WAY DESIGNATED IN THE TOWN OF MENTOR, CLARK COUNTY WISCONSIN

The Town Board of the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Amendment of Section 1. (A) (1). Section 1. (A) (1) of Ordinance No. 104 of the Ordinances of the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin is hereby amended to read as follows:

(1) Main street for all vehicles traveling in both a northerly and southerly direction.

SECTION 2. Creation of Section 1. (A) (3). Section 1. (A) (3) of Ordinance No. 104 of the Ordinances of the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin is hereby created to read as follows:

(3) Clark Street for all vehicles traveling in a northerly direction.

SECTION 3. Creation of Sections 3. (D), (E) and (F). Sections 3. (D), (E) and (F) of Ordinance No. 104 of the Ordinances of the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin are hereby created to read as follows:

(D) MAIN STREET. Main Street from the northerly intersection line with Lake Emerson Road to the southerly intersection line with Lake Emerson Road. All vehicles traveling in an easterly direction on Lake Emerson Road shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in both a northerly and southerly direction on Main Street.

(E) FAIRVIEW ROAD. Fairview Road from the easterly intersection line with West Bluff Road to the westerly intersection line with West Bluff Road. All vehicles traveling in both a northerly and southerly direction on West Bluff Road shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in both an easterly and westerly direction on Fairview Road.

(F) HICKMAN ROAD. Hickman Road from the northerly intersection line with Bain Road to the southerly intersection line with Bain Road. All vehicles traveling in an westerly direction on Bain Road shall yield the right-of-way to all vehicles traveling in both a northerly and southerly direction on Hickman Road.

SECTION 4. PENALTIES

(A) Forfeiture Penalty. Any person who shall violate this ordinance shall be subject to a forfeiture of not less than twenty dollars (\$20) nor more than forty dollars (\$40.00) for the first offense and not less than fifty dollars (\$50) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100) for the second offense within a year, measured from date of arrest to date of arrest, together with court costs and fees as prescribed by Wis. Stat. §§ 814.62(1) and (2) or 814.65(1) (1999-2000), the penalty assessment imposed by Wis. Stat. § 165.87 (1999-2000), as amended, where applicable. Payment of the judgment and applicable court costs, fees, assessments and surcharges may be suspended by the sentencing court for not more than sixty (60) days. Any person eighteen (18) years of age or older who shall fail to pay the amount of the forfeiture, court costs, any penalty assessment or other penalty imposed for violation of this ordinance may, upon order of the court entering judgment therefor and having jurisdiction of the case, be imprisoned until such forfeiture, costs and assessment are paid, but not exceeding ninety (90) days.

(B) OTHER SANCTIONS.


(1) By the Court. Nothing herein shall preclude or affect the power of the sentencing court to exercise additional authorities granted by the Wisconsin Statutes to suspend or revoke the operating privileges of the defendant, in addition to payment of a monetary penalty or in lieu of imprisonment.

(2) By the municipality. No person who has been convicted of a violation of any provision of this ordinance shall be issued a license or permit by the Town, except a dog license, until the forfeiture imposed for the violation and any court costs, fees, penalty assessment or surcharge has been paid in full.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed severable and it is expressly declared that the Town Board would have passed the other provisions of this Ordinance irrespective of whether or not one or more provisions may be declared invalid and if any provisions of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstances is held invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance and the application of such provisions to other persons or circumstances shall not be effected thereby.


SECTION 6. CONFLICTING ORDINANCES. Ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the above Ordinance are hereby repealed.
