

**Dogs Running at Large Ordinance
Ordinance No. 121**

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Mentor
Clark County

The Town Board for the Town of Mentor, Clark County, Wisconsin do hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Dogs Running at Large

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person owning or possessing any dog or cat to permit the same to run at large. A dog or cat is considered to be running at large if it is off the premises of its owner and not on a leash and under the control of the owner or some other person.


(b) A dog that is actively engaged in a legal hunting activity, including training, is not considered to be running at large if the dog is monitored or supervised by a person and the dog is on land that is open to hunting or on land on which the person has obtained permission to hunt or to train a dog.

(c) Penalty. If the owner of a dog negligently or otherwise permits the dog to run at large the owner shall forfeit not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 for the first offense and not less than \$50 nor more than \$200 for subsequent offenses.


