MINUTES

Assembly [Bill 371](#), was passed.

Letter from the Department of Transportation explaining the Transportation Alternative Program (TAB). The Town will receive 50% reimbursement for the culvert on Elger Road.

Treasurer Report was read. Supervisor One, Carol Johnson made a motion to accept this month's town bills, starting with check number 13461 to 13491, plus the E-checks. Supervisor Two, Robert Dobson 2nd the motion. Motion carried.

The town will receive 75% reimbursement for 6 of the roads that were damaged in the Labor Day storm. The town will not receive any reimbursement for Dam and Main Street.

Scott Sanders, from the Humbird Fun Day Committee, discussed getting a key to the hall for their meetings, also stated the committee would like to use the hall for their Rummage Sale on the 6th & 7th, of May, 2016.

Snow Plowing: Steve Pozega will be plowing the roads and Basil Tollefson will plow the driveways and help Steve plow the roads. If we get a bad storm driveways will not be plowed until all roads are plowed. Supervisor One, Carol Johnson made a motion to purchase materials for the chains on the town dump truck. Supervisor Two, Robert Dobson, 2nd the motion. Motion carried.
