MINUTES

The Town of Mentor Board held a Special Meeting on August 28th, 2017 at 5:30 p.m. at the Mentor Town Hall. In the Clerk's office.

Chairman Gile called the meeting to order.

All Board members, Merrilan Chief of Police, Mike Johnson, and Town's Attorney Garrett Nix were present.

Verification of posting: Notice was posted on August 24, 2017. By the Post office, Hall Door, and in front of the hall.

Review and discussion:

- A. Amend Ordinances Number 105 - Adopting Wisconsin Traffic Laws
- B. Amend Ordinance Number 113- Regulation of Abandoned, Junk, and Inoperable Vehicles.
- C. Ordinance Number 126 – Creating Restrictions for Sexual Offenders.
- D. Ordinance Number 125 – Regulating Length of Lawns and Grasses.

The above Amendments and Ordinances will be completed for possible motion to adopt, at the September 12, 2017 Regular Monthly Town Board Meeting.

The owners at following locations below, will be receiving a twenty-day letter to fix the issues at hand:

1. Property located at N3023 Clark Street. Owner needs to move the building 15 feet back. The building is located on the town's right- a- way.
2. Property located at N3054 Jackson Street. Owner must remove the cement slab that is located in the town's alley.

The Clerk will be sending out letters to certain property owners stating, that as of January 1, 2018 the town will not be mowing their property located in the Village of Humbird. Also, a list of lawn mowing contractors and a copy of the town's Ordinance 125- Regulating Length of Lawns and Grasses will be included with this letter.
